

## NOTICE TO AUTHORS

The *Australian Entomologist* has entered into an arrangement with INFORMIT (see [www.informit.com.au](http://www.informit.com.au)), an electronic subscription agency owned by RMIT University, Melbourne. INFORMIT is the main supplier of electronic subscriptions to academic, hospital and government libraries in Australia. INFORMIT also indexes subject matter in the text and provides on-line searchable access to individual papers which are downloadable for a fee by researchers around the world. *Australian Entomologist* will receive royalty payments from sales of both subscriptions and individual downloads by INFORMIT. This income will subsidise our production costs which are now borne solely by subscribers and authors. The searchable access provided by INFORMIT will also make the work of our authors available around the world.

Because we will now be generating an electronic version of the magazine, we will supply PDFs identical to the printed version to authors automatically and consequently the number of reprints supplied will be reduced to 10. The new arrangements will start with Vol 37 at the beginning of 2010. We will also supply a full electronic version of each issue to INFORMIT. They will modify this to supply to their electronic subscribers. They will also generate separate PDFs of each paper for supply to clients who purchase individual papers. These PDFs may be modified from the published format and will bear INFORMIT imprints.

### COPYRIGHT

Copyright of papers in *Australian Entomologist* belongs to the authors (or to their employers) and these parties are free to disseminate their work as they wish. This includes placing electronic versions of their papers on their own, or their institution's, web pages. Authors are free to do this with the PDF version which *Australian Entomologist* supplies to them. They are free to send that PDF version to anyone they wish. However our arrangement with INFORMIT requires that all authors give written permission for INFORMIT to use their work for the whole issue and PDF versions described in paragraph 2 above. INFORMIT will have exclusive permission to distribute these versions, and authors will not be allowed to distribute these versions. Authors must sign this declaration at the time their paper is accepted for publication. This declaration does not affect their copyright and does not inhibit their use of the material for any other purpose. INFORMIT is simply being giving what is called a "non-exclusive, third party license" and such agreements are now common in this electronic information age. But authors must sign this agreement (below) before their paper will be published in *Australian Entomologist*.
